This morning (October 13) the whole country of Ukraine is being attacked heavily. It has been 4 hours of air raid sirens so far. A missile or one of those drones from Iran hit a small town about 20 km from us. Please lift us all up in prayer. 75 missiles launched in the last three hours; 41 of them the Ukrainian army intercepted. As of right now another 45 are on their way. We are clearly reminded that this isn't the time to relax. Infrastructures have been targeted again recently. Half of our city (not our home, thankfully) today was without electricity and water. A lot of people and even kids in school basements joined together to pray before they were sent to go home. Thank you for your prayers.

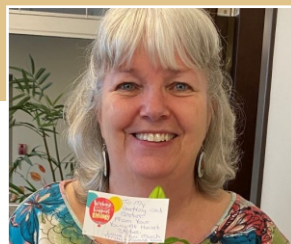

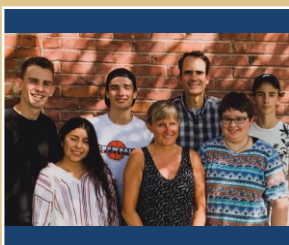
