Leader Applications will open February 11.

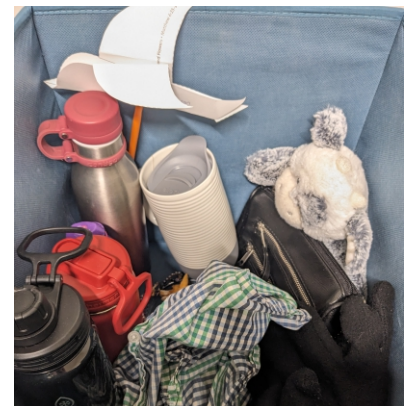
We will need help in all areas of Kids Camp. If you like to help out behind the scenes, being up front leading kids, or if you are creative and want to help decorate we have a job for you!
