POSITION PURPOSE

Three words: You're the pastor.

More words: The LifeGroup Leader supports the relational, spiritual, and leadership development of students. They will (1) serve as the hands and feet of ministry in Central Heights Youth, (2) embody the culture of Central Heights Youth (168, Movement of God, HOOYAGOONA), and (3) seek a movement of more and growing followers of Jesus, particularly among students.

ESSENTIAL FUNCTIONS AND BASIC DUTIES

1. Commit to one full year of leadership (September to May).
 2. Contribute 3-4 hours per week in volunteer hours.
 3. Participate in all Thursday night events (one night off for personal care per semester).
 4. Foster community for new and returning students.
 5. Disciple students to become mature followers of Jesus (largely by doing so yourself!).
 6. Empower student leaders in your LifeGroup.
 7. Partner with parents/guardians through relationship and clear communication regarding events, updates, and other important information.
 8. Dive into "the 168" (group chats, slushies, prayer, mid-week hangouts) – but don't burn yourself out.
 9. Participate in the Youth Team Retreat, the Youth Retreat, and four Youth Team Nights throughout the year.
 10. Pray for Central Heights Youth and Central Heights Church regularly.
