POSITION TITLE: Media Coordinator

POSITION PURPOSE

Two words: Generate hype.

More words: The media coordinator will oversee and advance Central Heights Youth's use of visual arts. They will be responsible for content creation that (1) celebrates God's work, (2) provokes momentum/excitement, and (3) embodies the cultural DNA of Central Heights Youth (168, Movement, HOOYAGOONA).

ESSENTIAL FUNCTIONS AND BASIC DUTIES

1. Commit to one full year of leadership (August to May).
 2. Contribute 3-4 volunteer hours per week (equal to a LifeGroup Leader).
 3. Create visual art that pushes towards seeing a movement of God.
 4. Photograph youth events two times per month and provide 15-25 edited photos by the following Monday.
 5. Complete special projects according to gifting (reels, message videos, merchandise, banners, etc.).
 6. Empower students for content creation (and use this opportunity to make disciples).
 7. Dive into "the 168" (group chats, slushies, prayer, mid-week content) – but don't burn yourself out.
 8. Participate in the Youth Team Retreat, the Youth Retreat and four Youth Team Nights throughout the year.
 9. Pray for Central Heights Youth and Central Heights Church regularly.
