POSITION PURPOSE

Three words: We want revival.

The Worship Director makes disciples through worship leadership. They will (1) raise up student leaders, (2) create space to encounter God, (3) inspire passionate worship all 168 hours of the week, and (4) *have a ton of fun*.

ESSENTIAL FUNCTIONS AND BASIC DUTIES

- 1. Commit to one full year of leadership (August to May).
- 2. Contribute 3-4 volunteer hours per week (equal to a LifeGroup Leader).
- 3. Create accessible space for students to encounter and worship God.
- 4. Once per month, lead Central Heights Youth in worship (and empower students to do so).
- 5. Oversee the different aspects of worship leadership (team assembly, rehearsal, prayer, sound, slides, song selection, setup, takedown).
- 6. Involve youth leaders, students, and/or other individuals to address tech needs.
- 7. Use Planning Center for advanced scheduling.
- 8. Dive into "the 168" (jam sessions, slushies, group chats, prayer, etc.) but don't burn yourself out.
- 9. Participate in the Youth Team Retreat, the Youth Retreat, and four Youth Team Nights throughout the year.
- 10. Pray for Central Heights Youth and Central Heights Church regularly.
